**** To get the most out of the workshop you will need a camera that allows you to manually control apertures, shutter speeds, and ISO settings. A lens that has manual focus is also a plus. Any recent model DSLR (digital single lens reflex) or ILC (interchangeable lens compact), will work. If you have a full featured point and shoot camera that has the four basic PASM modes (**P**rogram, **A**perture priority, **S**hutter priority and **M**anual) and makes them easy to use, you will do just fine.****

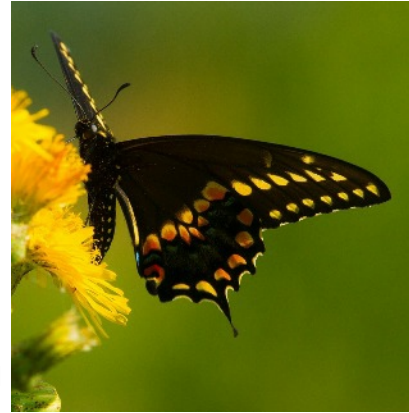
